

## **No Need to Mail-in Paper Tax Return with Modernized e-File System for New Hampshire Interest and Dividends Tax Returns**

The New Hampshire Department of Revenue Administration (NHDRA) in partnership with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) began accepting certain 2014 Interest and Dividend Tax (I&D) forms (Form DP-10 I&D Tax Return and Form DP-2210/2220) electronically through the IRS's Modernized e-File System (MeF System) on January 29, 2015. The NHDRA is pleased to announce the initial success of the program and would like to encourage its continued use.

In light of receiving duplicate I&D tax return submissions, the NHDRA would like to remind taxpayers and tax practitioners using the MeF System that there is no need to mail-in a paper I&D tax return. Only the I&D payments should continue to be made to the NHDRA either through the NHDRA website or by mail.
